Spring Recital will be held on May 20, 2012 at Carroll Community College.

Introduction to Dance. The ages 2 & 3 classes are used as an introduction to several dance forms including Ballet, tap and creative movement. The 3 year old introduction class is for students who have had 1 session of prior dance experience and are 3 years of age prior to the first day of class.

Ballet. Ballet class consists of barre, center, and combinations in both adagio and allegro (slow and quick movements), all of which stress proper body alignment, flexibility and muscular control.

Tap. Students learn Tap terminology and to apply rhythm and timing into a Tap routine. Tap dance develops a strong sense of rhythm as well as coordination.

Musical Theater. The classes throughout this program involve improvisational theater games, song and performance study. The students will be building their confidence and exploring their creativity while learning and performing.

Jazz. These classes help to develop stretch, strength, and coordination as combinations and routines are introduced. Students learn various forms of movement and the wide terminology utilized in this form of dance.

Hip-Hop. This exciting new dance style can be seen on popular music video productions. Used as a great body strengthening technique, dancers will learn the fundamentals of hip-hop.

Junior Dance Company. Open to all dancers 7-10 years old with **2 years prior dance experience.** Dancers will receive 60 minutes of technique and 30 minutes of choreography. The Junior Dance Company will be asked to participate in additional community performances and the Spring Recital.

Senior Dance Company. Open to all dancers 10 years and older with **4 years prior dance experience.** Dancers will receive 60 minutes of technique and 30 minutes of choreography. The Senior Company will be asked to participate in additional community performances and the Spring Recital.

POLICIES. Students must sign in upon arrival and meet their parents in the cafe area for pickup. Makeup classes will be offered for students enrolled in weekly classes. Kindly pre-arrange to make up classes during a similar class in the same session. There may be times when we cannot offer a make up class. Refunds/credits will not be given for missed classes. Students are not allowed to eat, drink or chew gum in class. Students enrolled in a 1-hour class may bring a water bottle.

ATTIRE

Introduction to Dance. Students should wear pink leather ballet slippers (no satin slippers), black buckle tap shoes, leotard or unitard (no skirts, ruffles or tutus), and light pink tights or socks.

Ballet. Students should wear pink leather ballet slippers (no satin slippers), leotard or unitard (no skirts, ruffles or tutus), and light pink tights or socks.

Tap. Students should wear black tap shoes (buckle tap for younger students, jazz tap for students in adult sizes), leotard (no skirts, ruffles or tutus), unitard, black jazz pants, bike shorts, and tights or socks.

Jazz & Hip-Hop. Students should wear black jazz shoes, leotard or unitard. Students may wear tights or jazz pants. T-shirts may be worn for warm-up.

Musical Theater. Students should wear black jazz pants, T-shirt and comfortable shoes. Jazz shoes may be required.
